#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Virginia Museum of Fine Arts (VMFA) Director and Chief Executive Officer Alex Nyerges welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 1:30pm.

#### II. THEATER HISTORY AND RENOVATION PLANS

Mr. Nyerges presented an overview of the history of the museum and its current renovation plans for the Leslie Cheek Theater, which include expanding the stage, improved lighting and audio-visual systems, and enhanced accessibility. The renovations are slated to begin in early 2024 and will conclude in September, possible. He noted the opportunities the renovation provides to expand the museum's audiences and community partners, including with the Richmond Ballet that will hold their studio series at Cheek Theater.

#### III. RENOVATION FUNDRAISING

Mr. Tom Gutenberger, VMFA Chief Development Officer and Deputy Director for Advancement, provided an update on the renovation's fundraising progress. He noted that currently \$2,356,500 has been raised of the project's anticipated \$8 million goal.
