### Day 1: Depart U.S. for Toulouse, France

**Day 2: Arrive Toulouse/Sorèze** We arrive in Toulouse today and transfer to the Midi-Pyrénées town of Sorèze and our lodgings, a former abbey listed as a historic landmark. Tonight we meet our Odysseys Unlimited Tour Director and fellow travelers at a briefing about the journey ahead, followed by a welcome dinner at our hotel. **D** 

**Day 3: Sorèze/Albi** Today we travel to the historic market town of Albi, hometown of Belle Epoque artist Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec. A city tour includes a visit to Palais de la Berbie, an ancient fortress housing a museum devoted to the works of Toulouse-Lautrec. **B** 

Day 4: Sorèze/Carcassonne/Perpignan En route this morning to Carcassonne, we stop in Mirepoix, whose Place du Maréchal-Leclerc is perhaps the quintessential medieval square. We have time to admire this masterpiece of urban design before we continue on to Carcassonne. Sitting atop a hill overlooking vast green plains that stretch as far as the Pyrénées, fortified Carcassonne boasts the longest city walls remaining in Europe, with battlements and ramparts dating to the 1st-century Romans. Late this afternoon we depart for Languedoc and our hotel in Perpignan. *B,D* 

#### Day 5: Perpignan/Figueres, Spain/Collioure

Today's excursion showcases the beauty of art and of nature, as we set off through the majestic Pyrénées. Our first stop is in Figueres, Spain, birthplace of surrealist artist Salvador Dalí and where we visit the acclaimed museum he designed to exhibit his work. From here we travel along the Catalan coast to Collioure, France, the "City of Painters" immortalized by such artists as Dérain, Matisse, and Picasso, among other Fauvists. We explore this charming town with its impressive castle, Chateau de Collioure; medieval streets; and Mediterranean bay. *B*<sub>1</sub>*L*<sub>2</sub>*D*

**Day 6: Perpignan** This morning we visit Abbaye de Fontfroide, the  $11^{\text{th}}$ -century monastic complex that ranks as the best preserved Cistercian monument in France and a key site in Languedoc. We tour the church and its cloisters then return to our hotel, with the remainder of the day at leisure. B

### Day 7: Perpignan/Canal du Midi/Le Pontet

We embark on a half-day cruise aboard a traditional flat-bottomed boat on the grand 17<sup>th</sup>-century Canal du Midi, one of the waterways connecting the Mediterranean to the Atlantic. Once a channel of kings and commerce, the canal today is a UNESCO site and a prime draw for boaters and tourists. We disembark mid-day then continue by coach to Provence. *B,L,D* 

Day 8: Le Pontet/Avignon Today we encounter the ancient Roman city that was the capital of Christendom in the Middle Ages. We visit Avignon's historic city center, a UNESCO site, with its cathedral, half-finished Saint-Bénézet Bridge, and the Palais des Papes (Papal Palace), one of the world's largest and most important Gothic structures. We tour the palace, where seven successive popes lived during the 14th century. After time for lunch and to explore on our own, we visit Pont du Gard, the 1st-century Roman aqueduct with three tiers of arches spanning the Gardon River. Skillfully engineered and artistically designed, the aqueduct, now a UNESCO site, carried water to residents of Nimes for almost 500 years. B

Day 9: Le Pontet/Arles We explore more of Roman France today in Arles, once part of Roman Gaul then a clarion of Christianity. Our tour begins at the Archaeological Museum, where we get an overview of the town's rich history through prehistoric artifacts, Roman statues, and

mosaics from the nearby Arles Amphitheater. Then we continue on a city tour to see some of Arles' ancient Roman monuments, all UNESCO sites, including the two-tiered amphitheater (c. 90 cE) itself. Tonight we join a local chef for a cooking class followed by dinner. *B,D* 

Day 10: Le Pontet/Saint-Rémy-de-Provence/Saint-Maximin This morning we leave for Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, the picturesque village where Van Gogh once painted. After a walking tour of the ancient Gallo-Roman city center with its maze of winding streets and fountain-filled squares, we have time to explore. Mid-afternoon we depart for Saint-Maximin in the heart of Provence. *B.D* 

#### Day 11: Saint-Maximin/Aix-en-Provence

Today we visit the Provençal town of Aix-en-Provence ("Aix"), known for its beautiful Cours Mirabeau, the plane-tree lined main boulevard; elegant Roman fountains; and as the birthplace of

artist Paul Cézanne. We take a walking tour here, admiring Aix's rich architectural heritage, then have time to explore as we wish. We return to our hotel late afternoon; we have the option to return to Aix this evening for dinner on our own. **B** 

**Day 12: Saint-Maximin/Roussillon** Our destination today: the "most beautiful village" of Roussillon, in the heart of one of the world's richest ochre deposits. With its red-hued cliffs, redstone buildings, and red-tiled roofs, Roussillon poses a striking image against the blue Provençal sky and pine forests of deep green. Tonight we visit a local winery for a tasting and dinner. **B,D** 

Day 13: Saint-Maximin/Saint-Paul-de-Vence/Èze/Cannes Scenic overload continues on today's visit to hilltop Saint-Paul-de-Vence, with its art galleries, museums, vine-covered stone walls, and breathtaking views of the mountains and sea. Our visit here includes the Maeght Foundation, with its prized 20th-century collection of fine arts. This afternoon we travel on to the charming village of Èze, high above the Côte d'Azur, where we have time to wander the cobblestone streets and enjoy panoramic Mediterranean views. Then we continue on to Cannes and our beachside hotel. B

#### Day 14: Cannes/Monte Carlo, Monaco

Today we embark on a morning city tour of Monaco's capital including the Prince's Palace (where Princess Grace lived), the famed Monte Carlo Casino, and the roadway where the Grand Prix motor race takes place. Tonight we gather for a farewell dinner. *B*,*D* 

**Day 15: Depart for U.S.** This morning we transfer to the Nice airport and our connecting flights to the U.S. *B*

Dr. Peter Justin Moon Schertz has served as curator of Ancient Art since October 2006 and the Jack and Mary Ann Frable Curator of Ancient Art since 2007. He received a

Certificate of Museum Studies in 1997 and a PhD in classical art and archaeology in 2004 from the University of Southern California, where he wrote the dissertation Seer or Victim? The Figure of Marsyas in Roman Art, Religion, and Politics under the supervision of John Pollini. He received his BA in classical languages and literature from the University of Chicago in 1987. His specialty is Roman art, with a focus on the intersection of art and culture, particularly art and religion. His current projects include a study of the original polychromy of the Arch of Titus and an examination of the Second Temple in Jerusalem in its Roman context. He is particularly interested in how new technologies can help us understand and interpret ancient art and is also preparing a major exhibition drawn from museum and state collections in Italy that explores how ancient peoples communicated with their gods (scheduled to open Spring 2017).
