ITINERARY IN BRIEF

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

Day 1: September 13, 2017
Depart U.S.

➤ Depart the U.S. for Frankfurt, Germany.

Days 2-3: September 14-15, 2017
Frankfurt

➤ Explore one of the great rivers of Europe and Germany's historic highway of commerce and industry – the Rhine. Enjoy a full-day excursion – including a relaxing cruise – through the Rhine River Valley.

Day 4-5: September 16-17, 2017
Baden-Baden
(Black Forest)

➤ Discover the romantic university town of Heidelberg on a tour featuring the Old Town, Carl Theodor Old Bridge, Heidelberg Castle, and lively Market Square. Explore the Black Forest, traveling first to Freiburg, then to Triberg.

Day 6-8: September 18-20, 2017
Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Munich

➤ Travel along the shores of Lake Konstanz through scenic Bavaria, home to the breathtaking Bavarian Alps. Encounter Neuschwanstein, Ludwig II's 19th-century Romanesque Revival palace that was the inspiration for Walt Disney's *Sleeping Beauty* castle. Take a horse-drawn carriage ride and take a tour of Munich, Germany's most prosperous and highly livable city.

Day 9: September 21, 2017
Nuremberg

➤ Travel to Dachau, site of Germany's first concentration camp and today a memorial, then continue on to Nuremberg where you will visit several sites associated with the Nuremberg Trials.

Days 10-14: September 22-26, 2017
Dresden, Berlin

➤ Continue on to Bamberg, walking through its medieval cobblestone streets, then arrive in Dresden where you will tour the beautiful Semper Opera House and the Historic Green Vault. Visit a porcelain factory in Meissen, then experience Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag parliament building, the Pergamon Museum, and the German Historical Museum in your tour through Berlin. Stop at the Berlin Wall Memorial. Enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 15: September 27, 2017
Depart for U.S.

➤ Transfer to the Berlin airport for your return flight to the U.S.
