The theme of this year's Art Museum Day is *Art Museums Foster Vibrant Communities*. AAMD members across the United States, Canada, and Mexico will be offering programs and initiatives to celebrate the arts and the important role art museums play in their communities. In addition to bringing the best of human creativity to people across North America, museums serve as engines for the creative economy, partners with school systems and civic organizations, and anchors for public spaces and neighborhoods—making their regions better places for everyone who lives and works there.

About Yves Saint Laurent: The Perfection of Style

Drawn from the unparalleled collection of the Paris-based Fondation Pierre Bergé - Yves Saint Laurent and other private collections, this breathtaking exhibition offers an intimate and comprehensive look at the lifetime achievement of Saint Laurent, one of history's most radical and influential fashion designers. *Yves Saint Laurent: The Perfection of Style* continues through August 27, 2017.

Featuring 100 examples of haute couture and ready-to-wear garments—some never shown publicly before—this exhibition reveals Saint Laurent's artistic genius, as well as his working process, and the sources of his design inspiration. VMFA is the only East Coast venue for the exhibition, which has been organized by the Seattle Art Museum in partnership with the Paris-based Fondation.

Yves Saint Laurent: The Perfection of Style is curated by Florence Müller, the Denver Art Museum's Avenir Foundation Curator of Textile Art and Curator of Fashion, in collaboration with Chiyo Ishikawa, Seattle Art Museum's Deputy Director of Art and Curator of European Painting and Sculpture. Barry Shifman, VMFA's Sydney and Frances Lewis Family Curator of Decorative Arts, 1890 to the present, is the organizing curator for VMFA.
