Keep in mind that exhibitions on view change from time to time, so parts of these maps may not always be current.

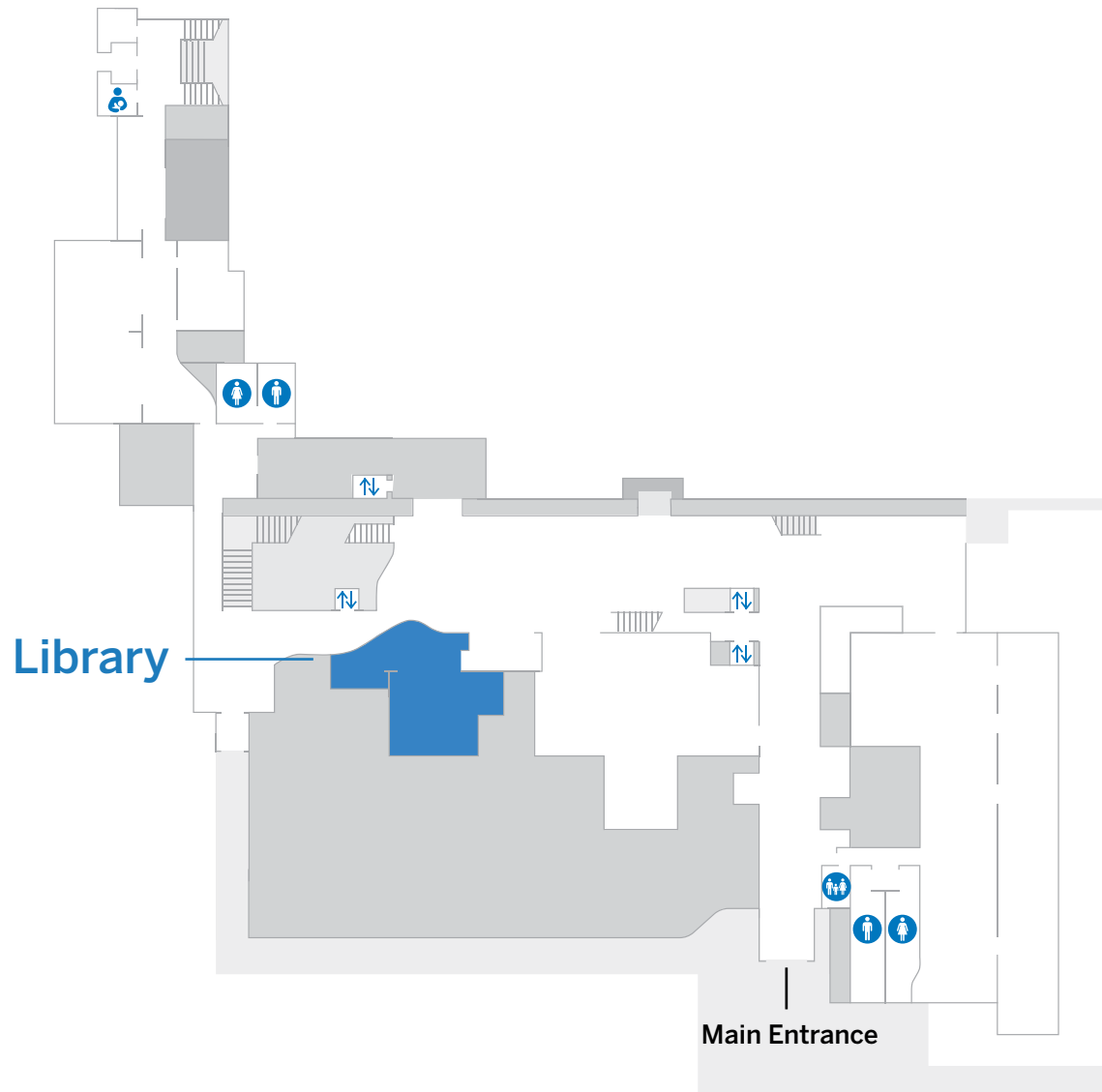
Sensory descriptions are based on an average day at the museum and may change due to heavy attendance, special programs, and other factors.

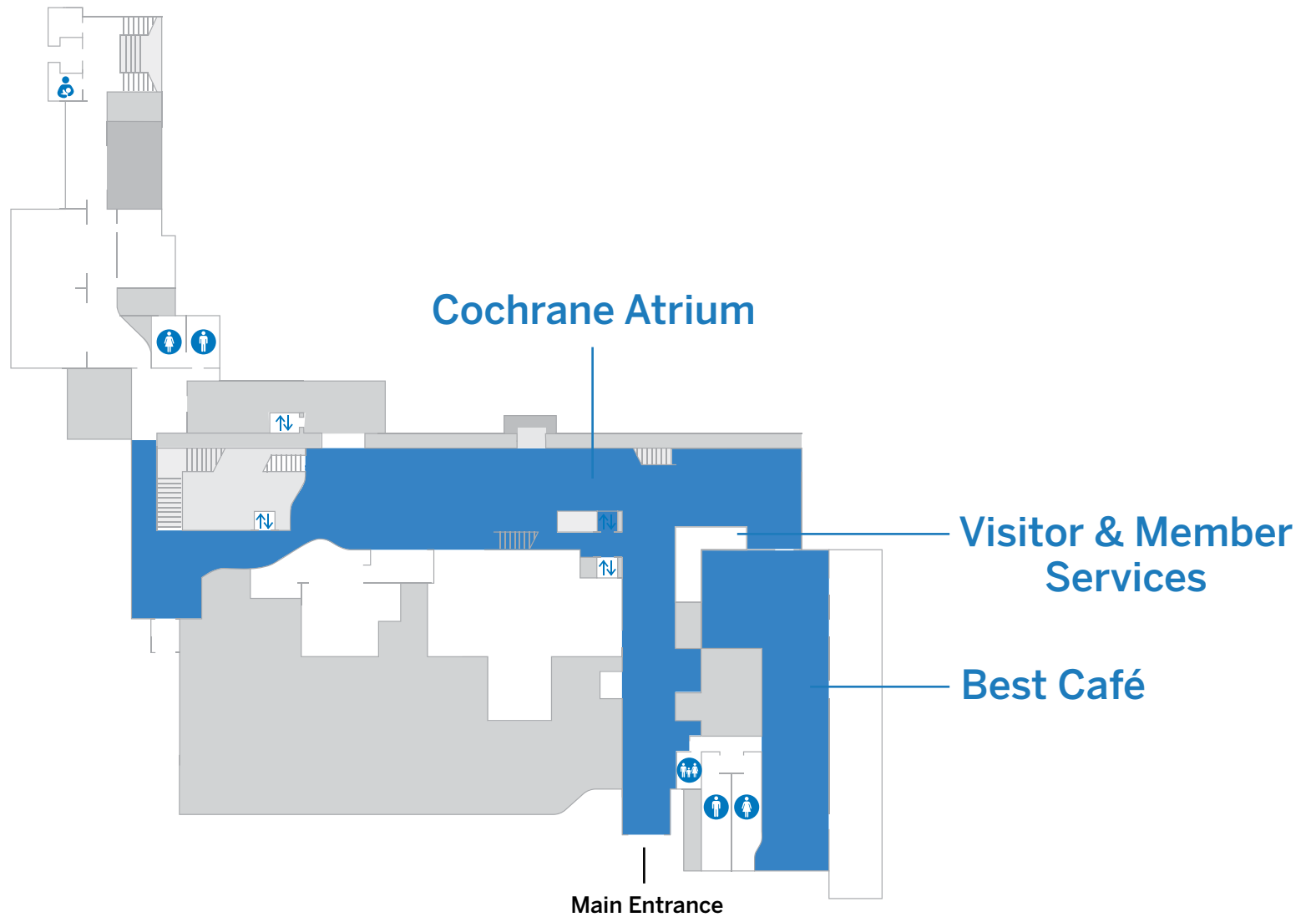
