TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Arrive in Vilnius, the lovely and historic Lithuanian capital. See the highlights of this city, a UNESCO site, including Cathedral Square, the President's Palace, and the fascinating KGB Museum. Travel to pastoral Trakai, Lithuania's medieval capital, and tour majestic 15th-century Trakai Castle.
- En route to the Latvian capital, Riga, stop at the Hill of Crosses pilgrimage site and visit massive 18th-century Rundale Palace. Take a city tour that includes the Art Nouveau Museum and the Old Town, and enjoy free time in this cultured Baltic gem. Travel to Sigulda to visit Gauja National Park, Latvia's premier nature preserve; and visit Gutmanis' Cave.
- Continue Estonia's capital, Tallinn, the northernmost Baltic capital, stopping in seaside Tallinn. Encounter the city's fascinating history on a city tour featuring the well-preserved medieval Old Town, and visit the Estonian Open-Air Museum at Rocca-al-Mare. Enjoy time at leisure to explore this charming city.
- Enjoy a three-night stay in St. Petersburg, Czar Peter the Great's "window on the West." See the awe-inspiring St. Isaac's Cathedral; the Peter & Paul Fortress; the Bronze Horseman statue; and the main shopping boulevard, Nevsky Prospekt. Join a local family for lunch conversation. Tour the world-renowned Hermitage Museum. Travel to the Romanovs' summer palace, Peterhof, and tour the Grand Royal Palace and gardens.
