
# **EGYPT & THE ETERNAL NILE**

**Days 1-4: January 25-28, 2016** Depart U.S./Cairo

Days 5-7: January 29-31, 2016 Abu Simbel/Lake Nasser Cruise

Days 8-11: February 1-4, 2016 Nile Cruise

Days 12-14: February 5, 2016 Luxor/Cairo

Day 15: February 8, 2016 Depart Cairo/Arrive U.S.

## **TOUR HIGHLIGHTS**

- Arrive in the Egyptian capital. Embark on a full-day tour including the acclaimed Egyptian Museum and the bustling Khan el-Khalili bazaar. Visit the open-air museum at Memphis. Continue on the necropolis of Sakkara then to the astounding pyramids of Giza, the true wonders of antiquity.
- Board your deluxe cruise ship on Lake Nasser. Visit the temples and colossal 65foot high statues of Ramses II and his wife Nefertari. Watch a dramatic sound-andlight show at Abu Simbel. Sail to Kasr Ibrim, the last remaining Nubian settlement. Tour the striking avenue of sphinxes at Wadi el-Seboua's "Valley of the Lions," then cruise to Aswan.
- Embark on a tour of the Aswan High Dam before boarding your Nile cruise ship. Sail along the Nile in *feluccas*, replicas of ancient Nile sailboats. Visit Edfu's Temple of Horus, Egypt's best-preserved temple. Enjoy a belly dance performance. Explore the West Bank, site of the haunting Valley of the Kings and the Valley of the Queens. See the massive Colossi of Memnon. Tour Luxor's East Bank, home of Karnak. Discover the Luxor Temple and the famed ancient obelisk found here.
- Disembark the Nile cruise and tour the Luxor Museum, housing relics discovered at the site. Fly to Cairo. Enjoy time for independent exploration. EncounterOld Cairo, the district where early capital cities once stood and now only remnants remain.
- > Early this morning transfer to the airport for return flights to the U.S.
