ITINERARY IN BRIEF

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Days 1-4: June 2-5, 2016 Depart U.S./Copenhagen
 Upon arrival in Copenhagen, enjoy a welcome dinner at the festive TivoliGardens. Tour the city's highlights including Rosenborg Palace and the Little Mermaid statue. Embark on a full-day excursion to Elsinore, site of Kronborg Castle, and visit the Karen Blixen House and Museum in coastal Rungsted.
 Days 5-8: June 6-9, 2016 Lillehammer/Gaala/Geiranger
 Board an overnight DFDS ferry to Oslo. Upon arrival, journey north to ski country. Stop in Lillehammer for a visit to the open-air museum at Maihaugen. Stay in a ski lodge hotel in the village of Gaala. Enjoy awe-inspiring scenery en route to Geiranger.
 - Embark on a series of ferry rides across Geirangerfjord. Tour Bergen, Norway's second largest city including Trolhaugen, country home of composer Edvard Grieg; the lively fish market; and the 14th-century Hanseatic merchants' quarter of Bryggen (a UNESCO site). Enjoy an hour-long excursion on the storied Flaam Railway hurtling through 20 tunnels spiraling in and out of the mountains. In Lofthus, enjoy visiting a family-run orchard and the next door salmon farm.

Get an up-close look at Norway's most dramatic fjord. Enjoy lunch at a local farm.

- Tour the pastoral Norwegian capital featuring the National Gallery with Norway's largest collection of fine arts, and enjoy a festive farewell dinner.
 - Transfer this morning to the airport for return flights to the U.S, or extend your visit in Oslo with a once in a lifetime treat – the special exhibition, "Jasper Johns/Edvard Munch: Between the Clock and the Bed" co-organized by VMFA and the Munch Museum in Oslo.
