TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Arrive in Scotland's largest city and enjoy a welcome dinner together. Tour the city's highlights, take a privately guided visit through Pollok House, ancestral home of the Maxwell clan and now a museum.
- Tour the bonnie banks of Loch Lomond, Great Britain's largest lake and a brief cruise. Continue on to Glencoe, one of Scotland's most beautiful spots with deep valleys and dramatic waterfalls. Enjoy a full-day excursion to the Isle of Skye, the largest of Scotland's Inner Hebrides known for its vivid history and stunning scenery.
- Drive the full 23-mile length of the fabled Loch Ness best known for the unearthly creature alleged to live in its waters. Take a privately guided tour of the historic Culloden Moor battle site. Explore the Highlands with an excursion along the Pictish Trail, sites connected with the late Iron Age/early Medieval Celtic people. Visit striking Dunrobin Castle & Gardens, where we see a falconry demonstration. Enjoy a sheep dog demonstration with working Border Collies in Kincraig and a visit to a small local single malt distillery in Pitlochry.
- Embark on a walking tour of legendary St. Andrews followed by a pub lunch together. Continue on to Edinburgh, the Scottish capital. A morning tour includes the 18thcentury Georgian "New Town" and the medieval "Old Town." A tour highlight is a reserved seating at the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo, an entertainment extravaganza set against flood-lit Edinburgh Castle. Encounter the Royal Mile, the historic boulevard connecting Edinburgh Castle with the Palace of Holyrood House.
- > Transfer in the morning to the Edinburgh airport for our return flights to the U.S.
