TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

Days 1-4: October 19-22, 2016 Depart U.S./Mumbai Encounter India's most populous city. Tour the acclaimed Prince of Wales Museum and take a traditional horse-drawn carriage ride to a festive welcome dinner. Embark on an unusual yet rewarding excursion to Dharavi, Mumbai's giant slum. Visit Crawford Market, the Raj-era arcade selling a wide variety of goods.

Days 5-8: October 23-26, 2016 Coorg/Kabini ➤ Enjoy your excellent accommodations at the Orange County resort set on a 300-acre working coffee and spice plantation. Take a guided walk of the property and attend a talk with the resident naturalist. Learn about the vast wildlife in this region on an early morning bird watching walk and a jeep safari through Nagarhole National Park. Visit Orange County's Butterfly Park and visit with a local family.

Days 9-11: October 27-29, 2016 Mysore/Bangalore

➤ Travel to Mysore and see one of India's most popular sights: Mysore Palace lit up with more than 98,000 bulbs. Visit the Chamundi Hills, site of Chamundeshwari Temple with 1,008 steps leading to the summit. Continue on to Bangalore, the "Silicon Valley," of India.

Days 12-13: October 30-31, 2016 Houseboat Cruise Embark on a two-night cruise along the palm-fringed canals of the Arabian Sea. See Indian life up close as you slowly cruise past small farms and villages, stopping on occasion to go ashore.

Days 14-15: November 1-2, 2016 Kochi

Disembark and return to Kochi, "Queen of the Arabian Sea," where you take a walking tour of Fort Kochi and attend a performance of traditional Kathakali dance. Enjoy free time to explore Kochi's Old Town.

Day 16: November 3, 2016 Depart Kochi/Arrive U.S. > Very early this morning transfer to the airport for return flights to the U.S.
