TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Depart the U.S. for Zagreb, Croatia. Tour this historic Croatian capital by coach and by foot. Visit Mirogoj Park Cemetery, Old Town, and St. Stephen's Cathedral. Experience the sights, sounds and smells of the Dolac open-air market.
- Drive to Plitvice Lakes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Fly to Dubrovnik and enjoy a walking tour through the Old Town, including Minceta Tower and the fortified city walls. Dine in the home of a local family and taste the produce from their garden. Enjoy a free day in Dubrovnik to discover its charms on your own.
- Travel the scenic route along the dramatic Dalmatian coast to Split, and cruise by ferry to Hvar, "queen" of the Dalmatian islands. Take a walking tour through the town of Hvar and then continue for a tour of Stari Grad, one of Croatia's oldest cities. Spend some time at leisure to appreciate the captivating natural beauty of our location.
- Return to Split, the main city of the central Dalmatian Coast. Tour the 3rd-century Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- En route to Opatija, visit the medieval town of Zadar. Tour Opatija as well as the Istrian Peninsula, known for its interesting history, lovely scenery, and good wines.
- Depart Opatija for Venice, stopping for lunch at an Italian farmhouse. Take a guided walking tour of the area surrounding vast St. Mark's Square. Enjoy some free time to discover the maze of canals before celebrating your journey at a farewell dinner.
- Depart Venice for return flights to the U.S.
