Days 1-3: May 21-23, 2015 Depart U.S./Zagreb

- ➤ Depart the U.S. for Zagreb, Croatia. Tour this historic Croatian capital by coach and by foot. Visit Mirogoj Park Cemetery, Old Town, and St. Stephen's Cathedral. Experience the sights, sounds and smells of the Dolac open-air market.
- ➤ Set out early in the morning for Lake Bled. Following lunch on your own, tour the magnificent Bled Castle and embark on a Pletna boat ride on the lake. Continue on to Ljubljana. Explore the capital and largest city of Slovenia by walking tour.
- ➤ Travel to Opatija, as well as the Istrian Peninsula, known for its interesting history, lovely scenery, and good wines. En route, stop for a visit at the Roman amphitheater in Pula and enjoy free time in Rovinj, a popular resort town with an active fishing port. Spend a day discovering Plitvice Lakes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- ➤ En route to Trogir, visit the medieval town of Zadar. Arrive early evening in the historic town of Trogir with time to explore the famous harbor before dinner at our boutique hotel.
- ➤ Drive along the dramatic Dalmatian coast to Split, the main city of the central Dalmatian Coast. Tour the 3rd-century Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Cruise by ferry to Hvar, "queen" of the Dalmatian islands. Take a walking tour through Hvar and then continue for a tour of Stari Grad, one of Croatia's oldest cities.
- Conclude your discovery of Croatia in Dubrovnik and enjoy a walking tour through the Old Town, including Minceta Tower and the fortified city walls. Enjoy a farewell dinner in the home of a local family and taste the produce from their garden.
- Depart Dubrovnik for return flights to the U.S.
