TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Depart the U.S. for Johannesburg, South Africa. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Embark on a tour of the Soweto district of Johannesburg, where you will see the home of former Archbishop Desmond Tutu; visit the home (now museum) of the late Nelson Mandela, and tour the Hector Pieterse Memorial and Museum.
- Enjoy in-depth touring of Victoria Falls including a sunset cruise on the Zambezi and an elephant-back safari through the bush of Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve, followed by a rhino safari. Visit Chobe National Park, where we take a morning game drive and an afternoon game cruise. Travel to Namibia's largest city, Windhoek. After a city tour, explore the central Namib Desert, where we have the opportunity to climb the sand dunes.
- Take a cruise along the storied Skeleton Coast, then fly to Cape Town, where we tour The Winelands. Here, we visit two wineries for tours, tastings, and lunch. Travel to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, where we ride a funicular to the summit for stupendous views of the meeting point of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans. Visit Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden, where native flora is preserved. Tour Robben Island, then return to Cape Town where we enjoy a farewell dinner together.
- Transfer to the airport this morning for your return flight to the U.S. Arrive in the U.S. and connect with your flight home.
