TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Tour the Polish capital of Warsaw including the rebuilt Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and the former Jewish Ghetto and the Jewish Cemetery.
- Travel south to Oswiecim – Auschwitz in German. Spend the afternoon with visits to Auschwitz and Birkenau concentration camps, now museums dedicated to chronicling the horrors of the Nazis' Final Solution. Enjoy a tour of Krakow, center of Polish culture and education, and tour the Wieliczka Salt Mines, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- Pass through Slovakia en route to Budapest, the capital of Hungary. Visit Matthias Church, the symbol of Buda's Castle District. Stroll around Fisherman's Bastion for outstanding views of the Pest side of the city over the river. Enjoy a typical Hungarian dinner at a local restaurant.
- Travel through the countryside of Western Transdanubia to Vienna. Stop in Szentendre, a small town packed with artisans' shops. Embark on a half-day tour of Vienna including a visit to the ornate Vienna Opera House. Attend a classical music concert in this most musical of cities.
- Take a coach and walking tour of Bratislava's historic Castle area. Enjoy dinner at the restaurant of a local family.
- Tour Prague's Old Town Square. Explore the Hradcany (castle) district, home of the distinctive castle towering above the Vltava River. Visit Gothic St. Vitus' Cathedral and stroll along Golden Lane, with its picturesque artisans' cottages. Tour Josefov, Prague's historic Jewish ghetto. Enjoy a farewell dinner in a palace in the Prague Castle complex.
- Depart Prague this morning for our return flight to the U.S.
