TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Depart the U.S. for Tokyo, Japan.
- Embark on a tour of Tokyo's top sights, including Shinto Meiji Shrine and historic Imperial Palace. Visit the gallery of calligrapher Koshun Masunaga and tour Ginza, Tokyo's famed shopping, dining, and entertainment district.
- Journey to Mt. Fuji-Hakone-Izu National Park. Take a coach ride for breathtaking panoramic views of imposing Mt. Fuji and a cruise on Ashi Lake. Travel to Hakone for an evening stay at a *ryokan*, a traditional Japanese inn.
- Continue on to Takayama in the Japanese Alps. Explore the town's San-machi-suji district with its authentically preserved small inns, teahouses, and sake breweries. Enjoy a sake tasting and leisure time to visit local shops. Visit Miyagawa Morning Market, meeting a local chef to gather ingredients we will use for a hands-on cooking class.
- Tour the UNESCO World Heritage site of Shirakawago Gassho-zukuri Village. Discover the culturally rich castle town of Kanazawa and its renowned Kenrokuen Garden. See Ishikawa Gate, Hakukokan gold leaf museum, and the Higashi Chayagai teahouse.
- Board the train for Kyoto, Japan's cultural and artistic capital. Spend a full day touring the highlights, including the lakeside Temple of the Golden Pavilion and ostentatious Nijo Castle, then visit nearby Nara. Take an optional cycling tour to visit the important Heian Jingu Shinto shrine; Nishiki Market; and the Gion district. Celebrate your adventure at a farewell dinner.
- Travel to Osaka, where you board your return flight to the U.S.
