I. CALL TO ORDER

President Lynette Allston called the meeting to order at 11:10am.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

III. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ms. Allston welcomed everyone and thanked them for accepting committee leadership roles. Ms. Allston shared several meeting scheduling updates. She also mentioned the new Trustee meeting earlier in the day and noted that they would be introduced at the full Board of Trustees meeting.

IV. FOUNDATION PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Virginia Museum of Fine Arts (VMFA) Foundation Board President Jay Olander reported that the Foundation Board of Directors met on August 17, 2022. As of August 31, 2022, Foundation assets stood at \$284,268,225, with overall return of -15.21% year-to-date and 2.4% quarter-to-date. Mr. Olander noted that the Foundation's annual audit is anticipated to be complete in early October and will be reviewed by the Board of Directors in November 2022.

V. DIRECTOR AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

Mr. Alex Nyerges, VMFA Director and Chief Executive Officer, introduced Andrew Harris, the museum's new Chief Financial Officer and Deputy Director for Finance and Budget Administration. Mr. Nyerges reported that the museum's fundraising and capital campaigns continue to thrive in the current economic conditions and thanked Tom Gutenberger, VMFA Chief Development Officer and Deputy Director of Advancement. Mr. Nyerges reported that fiscal year 2022 gifts and commitments to the campaign are at \$61 million, with significant gifts to close by calendar year-end. The capital campaign has been extended in light of the current inflationary period. The selection process for a construction manager-at-risk is underway and a finalist will be announced soon. Mr. Nyerges noted that museum attendance continues to rise closer to those of prepandemic times.

VI. OTHER BUSINESS/ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Ms. Allston moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Johnson seconded the motion, which was voted on and approved by the Committee at 11:54am.
