I. CALL TO ORDER

Trustee President Lynette Allston called the meeting to order at 2:00pm.

II. VMFA CODE OF ETHICS

Caprice Bragg, Executive Deputy Director and Chief Administrative Officer, reported that as part of the American Alliance of Museums' (AAM) routine reaccreditation process, a self-study was completed in November of 2024. Since then, the self-study documents have been reviewed by AAM. VMFA was asked to update two items; the emergency preparedness plan and the museum's code of ethics, which was last approved by the Board of Trustees in 1999. Since the due date for the revised document is prior to the next quarterly full board meeting and the Executive and Governance Committee can act on behalf of the full board in such matters, Bragg requested that the committee review and consider approving the suggested changes to VMFA's Ethical Standards. The bulk of the updates reflect the process of deaccessioning as outlined in VMFA's Collection Management Policy that the board approved in December 2023.
