I. CALL TO ORDER

Trustee President Lynette Allston called the meeting to order at 11:15am.

II. MINUTES APPROVAL

III. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Lynette Allston welcomed the committee, staff, and members of the public present.

IV. FOUNDATION PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Charlotte McGee, Foundation President, reported that the Foundation Board of Directors last met in May. During that meeting the board re-elected McGee as President, Larry Kochard as Treasurer, and Agustin Rodriguez as Secretary for one-year terms. Additionally, David Ford was elected to the board, Liz Blue and Michael Williams were elected to a second term, and the FY26 Foundation Budget was approved. McGee also reported that endowment assets are currently at \$300 million.

V. DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Director and Chief Executive Officer Alex Nyerges provided a brief report on the state of the museum, noting the success of *Frida: Beyond the Myth* and its associated programming. He also applauded the staff for staying within budget for the 89th consecutive year. He concluded by saying that campaign fundraising is 80% of the overall goal.

VI. CLOSED SESSION

Proposed that the 1.5% bonus for state employees included in the 2025 Regular Session Budget signed by Governor Youngkin will apply to the portion of Alex Nyerges' salary that is funded from private sources, and further that the 3% raise for state employees that was also included in the 2025 Regular Session Budget will also apply to the portion of Mr. Nyerges' salary that is funded from private sources. Motion carried.
