Shiva Paint Sticks: 1-colorless blender (optional)

Graphite pencil

White plastic eraser

Color wheel (optional)

Paint eraser or 4 writing pencils with erasers

Plastic paint scraper or single edge razor blade

Rags or roll of paper towels

Baby wipers or handi wipes to clean hands

You will get the most enjoyment from this class if you purchase Caran d' Ache NeoPastels **Oil Pastels**. They are softer ,more malleable and have richer color than their less expensive cousins. If you can't afford Caran d"Ache , <u>Sakura Craypas</u>, set of 16 would be a second choice. Oil pastels are not the chalky, soft pastels, but a soft waxy crayon.
