- Gelli Plate, 8 x 10 inches or larger.
- Soft printing brayer at least one 4 inches long and assorted sizes if you have them.
- Roll of good quality paper towels
- Baby wipes
- Tools for mark making Soft tipped cotton swabs, pencil erasers, soft commercial combs for pattern making, natural sponges, stencils, etc.
- Paints & mediums Acrylic paints in a variety of colors. I prefer Golden
 Open Acrylics, and Acrylic Glazing Liquid for mixing. Use water-based paints for Gelli Plates, no oils.
- Paper for printing Lightweight sketch book paper, Canson charcoal paper, craft paper, vintage paper – sheet music, maps, book pages – nothing glossy or textured.
- A piece of Plexiglas larger than your Gelli Plate.
- Gelli Plate Printing Book (optional). I have one to look at during class.
- Notebook/sketchbook
- Apron
