In plein air painting, it's best to have an abbreviated selection of what you would normally need for oil or acrylic painting.

- Portable pallet
- A couple of cotton rags
- Painting mediums in small resalable jars
- A couple of earth colors
- Primary colors
- White and a couple of additional colors that will fit into a portable carrying case.
- Limit your brushes to what you can carry but include a selection of round, filbert and one or two flat brushes.
- Small to medium sized canvases or primed wooden panels.
- A portable easel is a plus and a stool if you wish to sit while painting.
- You can make an easel out of a camera tripod. I can demonstrate.
- A bottle of drinking water.
