Must Haves

Cold Wax Medium (will be available at the workshop for \$5 or bring your own. I use Gamblin but Dorlands is fine)

Arches Oil Paper pad, 9" x 12", 12 sheets

1" painters tape (blue, white or green)

Palette knives (will used mostly for mixing paint)

Oil Paints (it is helpful to have dark, light, warm, cool and at least one transparent. If you plan to buy, student grade is fine and a Gamblin 1980 basic set is good.)

Nitrile gloves (purchase at drug store)

Messermeister Silicone Bowl Scraper. (Available on amazon or coldwaxacademy.com)
