MATERIALS

You may want to supplement your materials at intervals throughout the course. Begin by having a small range of materials to get started. Information on media and tools will be addressed as necessary. If you already have some supplies, start with those. If you have any questions, please contact me.

NOTE: On the first day, bring paints, brushes, supplies, and a painting support. **Painting Supports:**

Begin with an easel sized support in the range of 11"x14", 12"x16", 16"x20"

- Pre-stretched canvas
- Canvas Painting Paper
- Acrylic Painting Paper

General Painting Supplies:

- Soap for cleaning brushes
- Palette knife for mixing paints
- Charcoal pencil
- Linseed oil for oil paints (small amount, optional)
 - o Small jar with lid for linseed oil
- Turpenoid
 - Jar with lid for Turpenoid (for oils)
- Container for water (for acrylics)
- Disposable Palette pad (12"x16")
- Rags or paper towels
- Apron (optional)
- Notepad and pen, for notetaking

PAINTS

Titanium White Cadmium Yellow Ochre Raw Umber Burnt Sienna Cadmium Red Green Earth Viridian Cerulean Blue Cobalt Blue Ivory Black Indigo

BRUSHES - Begin with a small range (sm, med, lg) of either acrylic or oil brushes. Brushes used with both media are synthetic (soft), or hog bristle/natural hair. (stiff) Suggested size range: 10, 12,16, 20... Suggested styles are: brights, flats, filberts
