Supply List

Sketchbook of your choice.

A sketchbook doesn't need to be expensive, and it doesn't have to be purchased in an art store. There are no rules about whether it needs to be hardbound, wire bound or softcover, or about what kind of paper is inside. The important thing is to use the sketchbook you like, and to make sure the paper will support your favorite art materials, whether they're pencils, pens, paints or something else. I prefer a 8" x 10" wire bound sketchbook.

Pencil

Crayola washable markers, Broadline, box of 6 or 12

Your choice of any other media: pencil, pen, colored pencil, watercolors, or whatever you like.
