Supply List:

Scissors

Pencils

Straight edge. I recommend a metal ruler.

X-acto or Utility Knife

Bristol pad, Strathmore 300 series, 9 x 12 or 11 x 14

Cutting Board or Self-healing Mat. You can use the cardboard back of an old sketchbook or the back of your Bristol paper pad.

Glue Sticks(one large, one small) or PVA Glue

Drawing materials, such as ink pens and colored markers (Optional)

Backing Board is the material used to attached the collage materials to. You can use any heavy weight paper, mat board, cardboard. I recommend Bristol paper, also called Bristol board, which is acid free, heavy height and has a smooth surface. Available in different sized pads.

Collage materials can be any materials you would like to use in your collages such as photos, photocopies, magazine clippings, maps, sketches, old artwork, marbled & decorative paper, origami papers, stamps, letters, sheet music, newspapers, book illustrations, rubber stamps, any paper ephemera.
