

## Supply List for Mixed Media Illustration - VMFA 2024 -( Sarah Hand instructor)

1. **Printer paper - white.** 30 sheets - just an estimate. This will be used for a few different things, so just make sure to have some for each class.
2. **Scissors**
3. **Exacto knife/craft knife**
4. **Glue sticks - two:** you will want strong glue sticks, not school glue sticks. Here are my recommendations:

5. **Set of CHEAP oil pastels.** Don't buy expensive ones, okay? My faves:

6. **A box of crayons**(8 or 16). Any brand is great.
7. **A fine black sharpie** or other waterproof pen
8. **Pencil**
9. **Mixed media paper 9"x12"**: this will be our main paper, so it's important to have enough for mistakes and finished work. Here are my recommendations. Feel free to use other brands. But try to avoid any paper with a rough texture(like cold press watercolor paper), as it is slightly harder to do some techniques.

**10. Acrylic paint, any brand:** pick 5-7 colors you love (more, if you have it or want lots of choices). ANY brand. Craft paint is perfect, no need to buy fancy stuff. I will have some paint to share, but make sure you have your fave colors. I will have white and black.

**11. Cutting mat:** this is optional IF your mixed media pad of paper has a thick cardboard backing. The backing is perfect to use as a cutting mat. Otherwise, here's a good 9"x12" one:
