

VMFA VISUAL ARTS FELLOWSHIPS: A HISTORY

The Virginia Museum of Fine Arts Visual Arts Fellowship program is a vital source of funding for the visual arts and art history in Virginia. Committed to supporting professional artists as well as art students who demonstrate exceptional creative ability in their chosen disciplines, VMFA has awarded nearly \$5.5 million to over 1,250 Virginians to date.

VMFA's Fellowship Program was established in 1940 through a generous contribution by the late John Lee Pratt of Fredericksburg. Awarded annually through VMFA Statewide, VMFA fellowships are still largely funded through the Pratt endowment and are supplemented by annual gifts from the Lettie Pate Whitehead Foundation and the J. Warwick McClintic Jr. Scholarship Fund.

The professional artists, graduate students, and undergraduate students below are recipients of a VMFA 2015–16 or 2016–17 fellowship by independent jurors in an anonymous adjudication process. The images included here were submitted with the artists' original fellowship applications.






