Tickets on Sale Tomorrow at 10 am for VMFA's "Hopper Hotel Experience"

Visitors Have the Opportunity to Stay at the Museum Overnight in a Room Inspired by Edward Hopper's Western Motel

As part of the exhibition Edward Hopper and the American Hotel opening at the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts on Oct. 26, the museum will recreate Hopper's Western Motel as a three-dimensional motel space, giving visitors the chance to "step inside" the work of one of America's most celebrated artists. The "Hopper Hotel Experience" will afford visitors the opportunity to stay at the museum overnight in a room designed as a replica of Western Motel-one of Hopper's best-known paintings. Some of the "Hopper Hotel Experience" packages consist of dinner at VMFA's fine dining restaurant Amuse, a guided tour by the curator and an exhibition catalogue and mini golf at the newly opened Hotel Greene among other options.
