At-Home Art Activity: Photography Challenge Inspired by A Long Arc




Materials

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Notebook or clipboard
- Tape

Directions:

- Cut along the dotted lines of the rectangle above to create a rectangular-shaped cutout on this page. This cutout
 will become your viewfinder. TIP: To get started, fold the paper slightly and use your scissors to make a cut in
 the middle of the rectangle, then work your way to the dotted lines to cut out the rectangle shape.
- 2. Once you are done cutting, use tape to attach this page to the back of a notebook or clipboard, so that the viewfinder is visible.
- 3. Grab a pencil and get ready to pick a location/space to explore and test out your new photography skills with your viewfinder!
